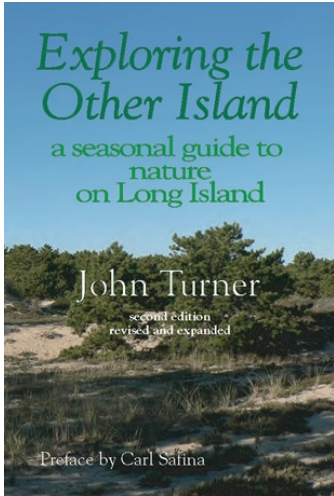


EXPLORING THE OTHER ISLAND
